REGISTRATION & PAYMENT INFORMATION

- Programs have different start dates/weeks.
 - O Please pay special attention to the specific dates of the programs. Some programs do not begin until March while others start as early as January.
 - o If you see an expected date "missing," this indicates either a no-school day OR a day the instructor is unavailable. These are not errors.
- Registration for MOST programs will occur online via the Jumbula registration system.
 - o Registration opens on Monday, November 6, 2023, at 7:00 PM (unless otherwise noted).
 - o Some programs have an external registration method or additional paperwork that needs to be completed prior to registration.
- Several programs will have limited enrollment.
 - O When enrollment fills, Jumbula will automatically switch the program status to "waitlisted." You are welcome to add your child's name to the waitlist or find other programs that are still open. There may be times when we are able to open an additional section if the waitlist pool is large enough.
 - o If space opens in a waitlisted program, you will receive an email from Jumbula to complete your registration if you still wish to enroll.
- The Clariden School is not responsible for weather-related cancellations. While we certainly try to minimize these last-minute cancellations, we appreciate your understanding if / when they occur.
- Please make note of these cancellation deadlines and policies:
 - The cancellation deadline for all programs is Friday, December 1st at 11:59 PM, unless otherwise stated on the program's registration page. All cancellations for Spring Term 2 programs must be made by Thursday, February 2nd at 11:59 PM.
 - o If you register for a program after the cancellation deadline but then need to withdraw from the program, you may cancel your registration and receive a full refund if you cancel within 24 hours of completing the registration.
 - o Please note that we will NOT prorate or provide refunds for cancellations beyond these dates or the 24 hour window.
